

Procedure for Appeal of Development Review Board Decision

Your Notice of Appeal must be received in the office of the Zoning Administrator within the thirty day appeal period that begins the date the Notice of Decision was signed.

Step One: Appellant

Send the following via Certified Mail to Michael Brands, Zoning Administrator, Woodstock Town Hall, P O Box 488, Woodstock, Vermont 05091

Step Two: Zoning Administrator

Upon receipt of Notice of Appeal, the Zoning Administrator will send the following via Certified Mail to Appellant

- List of Interested Parties
- Procedure for Appeal (this sheet)
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Step Three: Appellant

Upon receipt of list from Zoning Administrator, the Appellant needs to send to all interested parties:

- Notice of Appeal
- Cover Letter stating:
 - ▶ Interested parties have 20 days to notify the Environmental Court if they want to become party to the appeal
 - ▶ Environmental Court's address and phone number

Send the following via Certified Mail to the Environmental Court:

- Appellant's Notice of Appeal
- Appellant's Check (\$225 payable to Vermont Environmental Court)
- Appellant's Notice of Decision
- List of Interested Parties
